## Chick-fil-A buys property for new Triad restaurant

Chick-fil-A has purchased land for a new Triad location.

The Atlanta-based company bought a 1.53-acre lot at 1331 Glenn Center Drive in Kernersville for \$747,500 in a deal posted online Tuesday in Forsyth County. The location is off the west side of Union Cross Road, only a few dozen yards south of Interstate 40.

Stirling Building Group of Greensboro is the general contractor.

In December, Triad Business Journal reported that Chick-fil-A was coming to the growing row of businesses near the Union Cross exit off I-40.

The Chick-fil-A will be built between Bojangles and I-40 in The Shoppes at Glenn Crossing, which also includes O'Reilly Auto Parts (NASDAQ: ORLY), Tractor Supply Co. and Sheetz. Glenn High School is only a few yards to the south on the other side of Glenn Hi Road.
